LABEL TYPES

BUTT-CUT LABEL

A label made with square corners and no spacing between labels.

BLOWN-ON LABEI

Labels are positioned onto an item by air pressure.

BACK SLIT

Labels with linear cuts on the liner for assistance in the removal of the facestock from the liner.

CHEMICAL DRUM LABEL

A durable label made of vinyl, polyester, or kimdura to resist harsh conditions.

COMPUTER IMPRINTABLE LABEL | | | | | | | |

EDP coated labels compatible with laser or thermal printing.

CONTINUOUS/PINFEED LABEL

Labels used for data processing applications made on continuous fan fold paper.

DIE CUT LABEL

Pressure sensitive labels on a release liner with the matrix removed.

FACE CUT LABEL

Die cut or square cut label with no matrix removed.

LABEL TYPES

FAN-FOLDED LABEL

Pressure sensitive and perforated labels folded like a fan so that they will stack.

| | | | | | | FORM LABEL COMBINATIONS

Labels that are paired with forms via attachment like blown-on labels, or in a dual web construction, where half of the form is the label and the other half is paper.

KNIFE-CUT LABEL

Similar to Butt-Cut Label.

MULTI-WIDTH/MULTIPLE WIDTH

Usually referred to as a Pinfeed label, these have more than one label going across a page horizontally.

PIGGYBACK || || || ||

Labels often used with customer response cards. Two labels on one liner with the top label removed by the end user.

PRESSURE SENSITIVE LABEL

A pressure sensitive label face material with an adhesive applied to it.

PRIMARY LABEL

High quality labels often used for retail. Specially shaped and designed for jars, bottles, etc.



LABEL TYPES



Labels that use only static electricity to adhere; no adhesives.



Pressure sensitive labels that will break and not come off in one piece when removal is attempted.
